



West Texas Trail Walkers Membership Form (2017Rev4)

The West Texas Trail Walkers (commonly known as WTTW) is a club dedicated to holding a yearly event in the scenic areas of West Texas which are off-road and challenging. The one-time club membership fee is \$25 per individual. The membership fee entitles the member to the club privileges listed below and obligates the member with the responsibilities of assisting the club as a worker in at least one out of each five years. After five years membership without working, the member may need to rejoin for the \$25 fee.

Club Privileges:

- Receive one club patch (additional ones may be purchased). Patches not sold to non-members.
- Purchase T-Shirts and Sweatshirts with club logo. These are not sold to non-members.
- Receive award pins for participating as a worker in two, five, ten, fifteen, twenty or more events.
- Receive club notice of walk site ahead of public notice to enable members to make reservations.
- Vote on club affairs and the election of Board of Directors.
- Being part of an elite group of fun loving walkers who love the out-of-doors and a challenge to do the out-of-the ordinary walks.

Our trails are difficult; we require all walkers to carry their own water/snacks. We have a restricted start time window and many walks are not near lodging facilities requiring camping or driving a distance to the start point. We are different, but the walks are great. While difficult, ample time is available and the routes can be traversed by almost everyone (either 5, 10 or 20km).
