


Lighthouse Loop Trail (13.56 km, 8.42 miles)



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Park at the Capitol Peak Trail parking lot and start at the Lighthouse Trailhead. There are bathrooms at the Soapberry Day-use Area about a mile North of the parking lot See <https://caltopo.com/m/4H369> for an on-line map. Note that a GPX file of the route is also available. Hit the folder icon and click on 'Export.'

1. At the trailhead there are two paths. You can take either one.
2. At 0.44 miles take the trail to the right that heads north. It should be labeled, 'Lighthouse Trail'.
3. At 1.77 miles take the trail to the left that heads south to the Lighthouse Peak (0.9 miles).
4. At 2.73 miles you will come to an intersection for the Lighthouse Loop. The trail to the left is a bit more challenging, but shouldn't be a problem if you're in good shape. The trail to the right is about 0.1 miles longer but not as steep.
5. Follow the loop around the peak and return north on the same trail.
6. At the intersection turn left (heading is northwest, and mileage thus far is 4.11 miles).
7. At the intersection, turn left on to Givens, Spicer and Lowry Trail for 0.45 miles (total of 4.54 miles).
8. At the intersection, take the right trail and follow it for 0.10 miles to the next intersection. Continue on the Given, Spicer and Lowry Trail to the right.
9. Continue on the Givens, Spicer and Lowry Trail for 1.14 miles (total of 7.14 miles).
10. Turn right on the Kiowa Trail for 0.23 miles.
11. Keep to the right and follow the Paseo Del Rio Trail for 0.91 miles. Turn right at the road, cross the river and then turn right to the Lighthouse Trailhead. Total distance is 8.42 miles.
